TECH TIP by Judith Reid




How do you find what is pinned to your start up and how do you unpin things you don't want there? Also assists faster start up.

Right click on Microsoft icon (start up) scroll up to 'Task Manager', click.

If you don't see anything listed scroll to bottom & click on more details.

Click on 'Startup'

Most of these can be disabled except for your virus protector (scroll down)

Be aware you are not disabling them permanently, only stopping them from from slowing down your startup
